AFFIDAVIT FOR WARRANT OF ARREST AND DETENTION

The Undersigned Affiant, who after being duly sworn by me, on oath, makes the following statement:

I have good reason to believe and do believe that *ESLOBAN* ~~Areli Carbajal~~, H/M, 04/23/1979 on or about 05-31-2009, in Austin, Travis County, Texas, did then and there commit the offense *Filed in The District Court of Travis County, Texas*

My belief in the foregoing statement is based upon information provided to me by witness interviews, collection of evidence from the crime scene and information contained in Austin Police Department Offense Report 09-1510634.

Affiant is a detective with the Austin Police Department Homicide Unit and is therefore responsible for investigating homicides.

On 05-31-09, at 6:48 am a call was placed to Austin 911 in reference to an injured female at 7000 Decker Lane #2922, in Austin, Travis County. Austin Police Department patrol officers responded to the location and entered the apartment. Inside the apartment, Officer A. Wiese located a deceased female, later identified as, Bianca Maldonado 03-28-1992. Maldonado suffered what appeared to be multiple stab wounds to her body.

While on scene, Austin Police Officers identified the mother of the victim as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was interviewed by Austin Police Detective Guajardo. During the interview, [REDACTED] provided a sworn statement that she left the apartment at 3:00 am with her younger daughter to deliver papers. [REDACTED] stated that she returned to the apartment around 6:45 am and located Bianca with obvious serious injuries, wearing only a bra, and that an apparent struggle had ensued. [REDACTED] immediately called 911.

Homicide Detective Staniszewski responded to 7000 Decker Lane #2922 to investigate the scene. While performing his investigation, he observed a large amount of what he believed to be blood from the victim in the living room, on the victim, and around the crime scene. Due to Detective Staniszewski's past training and experience he believes that the suspect would have retained a large amount of blood on his person and clothes during the assault. Det. Staniszewski observed many obvious stab wounds to the victim. Detective Staniszewski also observed a purse and wallet in a bathroom sink. After searching the wallet, it appeared all the items from the wallet were taken. The only item left in the wallet was an identification card belonging to Bianca Maldonado.

manner of death as Homicide. Also during the autopsy, Dr. Dolinak observed signs of severe trauma to the vagina and anal area of Maldonado. Said injuries are consistent with Maldonado being sexually assaulted.

During the course of the investigation, a tip was received through crime stoppers from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was located and interviewed by Austin Police Detective K. Scanlon. [REDACTED] stated that that on the early morning of May 31st, 2009, [REDACTED] was asked by her boyfriend Areli Escobar to spend the night at his apartment, which is located at 7000 Decker Lane #2002, in Austin, Travis County. Apartment #2002 and apartment #2922 are located along the north side of the complex, and are separated by the driveway running through the complex. [REDACTED] arrived at the apartment around 2:30am. After arriving, [REDACTED] took a shower, visited with the residents, and went to bed. After [REDACTED] went to bed, she heard the door shut. [REDACTED] got up and realized that Escobar had left the apartment. [REDACTED] stated that she was angry that Escobar left the apartment, so she decided to return to her own residence. [REDACTED] stated when she left the apartment, she noticed that Escobar's vehicle, a Lincoln Navigator, was still in the parking lot, leading her to believe that he left the apartment on foot. [REDACTED] stated that she started to call Escobar's cell phone at 4:04 am. [REDACTED] stated that Escobar did not answer the first three times she called. Det. Scanlon reviewed [REDACTED] phone and discovered that the calls were placed at 4:04 am, 4:04 am, and 4:12 am. On the fourth call to Escobar's cell phone, which was at 4:15 am the line connected and she heard a female screaming. The call remained connected for 10 minutes and 24 seconds. [REDACTED] heard panting and moaning while she listening to the open line. The call times were confirmed by Det. Scanlon through a review of the recorded data on [REDACTED] cell phone.


The phone data was reviewed by Computer Forensics Detective Charles Riely. The following data was recovered from the cell phone belonging [REDACTED]. At 5:11 am, [REDACTED] sent a text message through her cell phone to Escobar's sister [REDACTED] stating that she had called Areli and heard him having sexual intercourse with another woman. A text message was then sent to [REDACTED] cell phone from [REDACTED] phone, at 5:26 am, stating that Areli had come over to his mother's house to change clothes because he had fought and had a bloody shirt, she also stated that he could not come home because someone might be looking for him.

At 5:45 am, [REDACTED] sent a message to her son [REDACTED] stating, "OMG i think Areli raped someone".

Another text message was sent to [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] at 12:06 pm, asking [REDACTED] if she found out what had happened. During [REDACTED] responses she stated that she spoke with [REDACTED] and Areli told him that he "F-ed up. The blood was sum girls and not his. My mom already washed his clothes 2x and she still cant get all the blood off. She said his clothes had tons of blood on it. Gosh idk what he did". [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] is the boyfriend of [REDACTED].


On 6-2-08, at 2:30 pm, Homicide Detectives J. Crawford and F. Rodriguez located Areli Escobar. Both Detectives observed a 2 1/2 inch laceration on the back of the right hand on Escobar. Additionally, Escobar had scratches about his face and elbow, and a purplish coloration that appeared to be a bruise. The injuries appeared fresh, and were consistent with the injuries occurring a couple of days earlier.

Texas Penal Code 19.03 in that Areli Escobar did intentionally cause the death of Bianca Maldonado by stabbing her multiple times with a deadly instrument during the course of committing an aggravated sexual assault. Your affiant, believes that based on the investigation it showed that the victim Bianca Maldonado was home alone on May 31st, 2009, from 3 am till 6:45am, and that Areli Escobar was in close proximity to Maldonado's residence during this time. At 4:15 am, a call was placed to Escobar's cell phone by [REDACTED]. During the call, [REDACTED] stated that she heard screaming, moaning, and panting. [REDACTED] believed that based on what she had heard, Escobar was "raping" someone. [REDACTED] then received text messages from Escobar's sister [REDACTED] stating that Areli's clothes was covered in blood, and that he had "f-ed up" and the blood belonged to a girl and was not his. Additionally, Escobar was observed with injuries that were consistent with injuries that would be received during a struggle.


