**AFFIDAVIT FOR WARRANT OF ARREST AND DETENTION**

The undersigned Affiant, who after being duly sworn by me, on oath, makes the following statement:  
I have good reason to believe and do believe that

Possession of Controlled Substance, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree Felony

On January 2, 2009 at approximately 0137, your Affiant was on duty as an Austin Police Officer wearing the uniform of my position with shoulder patches and badge on my chest. I was also driving a clearly marked Austin Police Department patrol unit equipped with emergency lights and the word "Police" on the vehicle. I was on patrol in the Downtown area, the 6<sup>th</sup> street entertainment area was barricaded off to vehicle traffic. I observed a white Lincoln 4 door car drive south bound in the north bound lane of Neches from e 7<sup>th</sup> street. The Lincoln drove south bound in the north bound lane in order to drive around the barricade. I stopped the Lincoln in the 600 block of Neches. When the Lincoln stopped the front seat passenger who was identified as Troy Tanksley quickly started to get out of the car. I could smell a strong odor of burned marijuana. Tanksley reached down toward the ground and I told him to stay and he kept moving his foot around on the ground. Tanksley finally sat back down in the front passenger seat and closed the car door. While I was telling Tanksley to stay in the car the driver of the car who was identified as Nathaniel Sanders opened the drivers door and leaned out. I told the driver to close the door. I then approached the driver and asked Sanders for his drivers license and insurance, Sanders stated he did not have either. I had Sanders exit the Lincoln, handcuffed him, and sat him on the curb. I then removed Tanksley and handcuffed him. When I began to search the car based on the strong odor of marijuana and the furtive actions by both Sanders and Tanksley I noticed a bag under the car near where Sanders had opened the door and leaned out. I recovered the bag which contained off white substance that I believed to be crack cocaine. Inside the passenger compartment of the car I noticed the ashtray was dislodged. I found a bag containing an off white substance that I believe to be crack cocaine:

On the ground where Tanksley had got out of the car I observed what appeared to be crack cocaine that appeared to have be stepped on and ground into the pavement. Austin Police Officer T. Brown #2351 began to search the right front passenger area of the car and found an off white substance that he and I believe to be crack cocaine on the floorboard and right front seat where Tanksley had been seated in the car. Officer Brown observed the panel under the dashboard on the passenger side of the car had been pulled down. Sitting on this panel was a Llama 9 mm pistol. The pistol was load with 7 rounds of ammunition in the magazine. When sitting in the front passenger seat this pistol can be seen and was only with in reach of Tanksley.

The suspected crack cocaine found on the ground beside the passenger door where Tanksley reached when I made the stop and the suspected crack cocaine found on the front passenger floorboard and front passenger seat tested positive for cocaine and had an approximate net weight of 3.4 grams.

The suspected crack cocaine found under the car where Nathaniel Sanders opened the door and leaned out and the suspected crack cocaine from under the ashtray tested positive for cocaine and had an approximate net weight of 31.7 grams.

Based on the furtive movement by Nathaniel Sanders and the fact that Sanders stated he had just bought the Lincoln I believe Sanders was in possession of 31.7 grams of crack cocaine.

Based on the furtive movement by Troy Tanksley I believe he was in possession of 3.4 grams of crack cocaine.

**ROBBERY BY ASSAULT**  
(Second Degree Felony)

My belief of the foregoing statement is based upon personal knowledge and the following information:

On 5-7-09 I was on uniformed bike patrol in the downtown area when I was dispatched to a 'Robbery Urgent' at E 6th St./Trinity St. When I received the call I was at 6th St./Congress Av. and began traveling eastbound on the north curb/sidewalk. As I approached San Jacinto St. I was flagged down by the victim, KNETTLER, TIMOTHY, W/M, who was on his cell phone with 911 call takers, and directing me to the suspect. Knettlar advised me that the suspect was a black male, tall and thin, wearing a red t-shirt and black shorts, and traveling eastbound (foot) on E 6th St. I continued east with no vehicle traffic and an open street clear to the frontage road of IH-35. I could clearly see a suspect matching the exact description, standing over an open trashcan on the north curb/sidewalk as he was removing items one by one from a wallet, examining each item and discarding each item into the trashcan, keeping one card. Once he was done he tossed the entire wallet into the trashcan and waited at the west curb for the pedestrian light. This is where I approached him on bike and pointed my Taser at him and ordered him to the ground. My uniform was clearly identifiable as a police uniform with distinguishable patches and badge, and I spoke in a loud and clear voice, ordering him to the ground. He refused to comply despite being ordered twice. Officer Gonzales #4949 got off of his bike and began taking the suspect, SANDERS, NATHANIEL, B/M, 5-30-90, to the ground. I got off of my bike and assisted him. Officer Gonzales had a hold of Sanders from the back of the neck with his left hand, pulling him down to throw off the suspect's balance. The technique was effective and Sanders' left temple and brow area made contact with very little impact with the ground causing a small abrasion on his skin. He had no complaint of pain for the injury, and would only say that he did not do anything wrong, and then ask "What did I do?". I checked the trashcan where Sanders discarded the items and wallet and noticed several credit/debit cards, business cards, and access card with Knettlar's name on the items. The items were gathered and Sanders was handcuffed (double-locked) and transported to the scene where Knettlar identified him as the person who committed the robbery. Sanders immediately began yelling at Knettlar saying it was the 'other guy'. Upon speaking with Knettlar, he advised me that he was parked in front of the Bank of America ATM - 500 San Jacinto St. He stood in front of the ATM and withdrew 100 dollars cash. Sanders approached him and asked if he could have money and was refused. Sanders hit Knettlar's left arm causing him to drop his money and wallet. Sanders grabbed the wallet and 3 twenty dollar bills and fled the scene. Knettlar's wrist was red from the impact and scratched from where his wristwatch was hit. He also had a complaint of pain for the injury. Knettlar advised he feared that Sanders' intention was to physically harm him by the assault and feared that Sanders was going to carry it out even further just before he fled. Knettlar's voice and hands were shaky and he had difficulty describing the incident as he tried to gain his composure. Knettlar verified the contents of his wallet and it was returned to him with all the items. He verified the 100 dollar transaction at the ATM with the paper receipt, counted the money on his person and advised he was missing 60 dollars in cash, in denominations of 20. All of the victim's property was returned to him.

Undersigned Affiant, Who After Being Duly Sworn By Me, On Oath, Makes The Following Statement:

**POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE- 3<sup>RD</sup> DEGREE FELONY**

Affiant's belief of the foregoing statement is based upon personal knowledge and information provided to affiant by officers of the Austin Police Department who personally observed such offense. Affiant is a peace officer assigned as a Detective to the Austin Police Department's Metro Tactical, Central Street Response Unit.

On 12-22-08, officers assigned to the Metro Tactical Central Street Response Unit were conducting a surveillance operation in the downtown 6<sup>th</sup> St. area. The unit was conducting this operation due to the high drug sales and drug usage in this area. In the past the unit has made numerous felony crack cocaine arrests in this area.

During the operation, Officer Guevara on foot (conducting surveillance in the 600 block of Red River) was just feet away when he observed and heard 3 subjects talking about doing a drug transaction. Officer Guevara watched the subjects and could see that two of the subjects had narcotics in their hands. One subject later id as:

**Ramzy, Samuel            B/M            1-19-74**

had a small clear plastic baggy of what appeared to be cocaine in his hand.

and the other subject who was later id as:

**Sanders, Nathaniel        B/M            5-30-90**

had several crack rocks in his hand.
